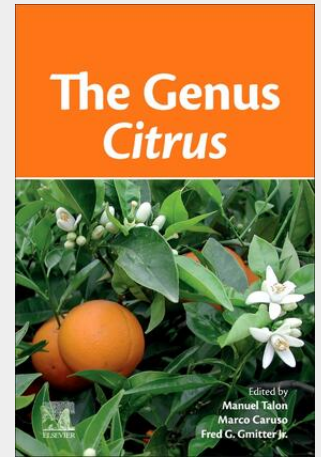


The Genus Citrus
