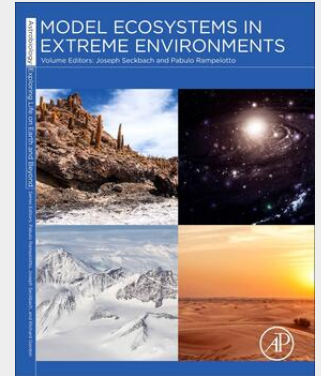


Model Ecosystems in Extreme Environments
