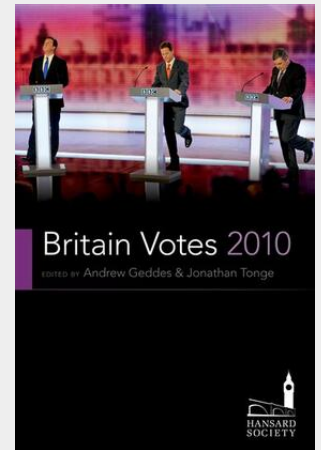


Britain Votes 2010
