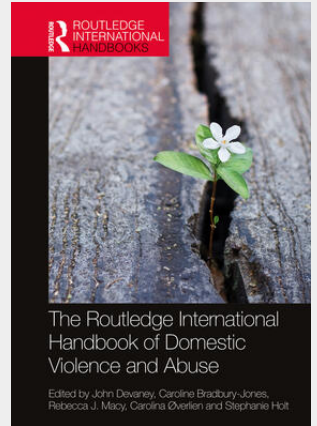


The Routledge International Handbook of Domestic Violence and Abuse
