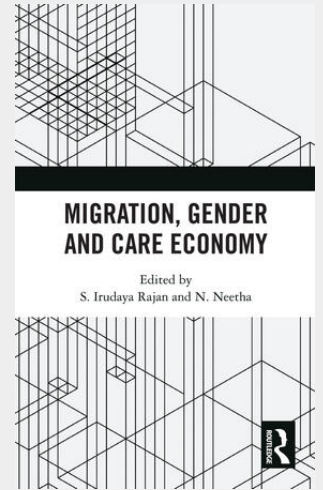


Migration, Gender and Care Economy
