Housing in Britain

The Post-War Experience

First published in 1982 at a time when housing policy featured prominently in the press and in political debate, *Housing in Britain* was written to provide an authoritative review of housing in Britain. The book is a comprehensive introduction to the major policy shifts from 1945 to the year of publication. It explores the many aspects of 'housing' as a matter of state policy; as a commodity with a certain market for its sale and exchange; as an essential item, with rules regulating access and eligibility; and as a vital element in the reproduction of social life. Particular attention is paid to the institutions involved within the British housing market, and the redistributive consequences of housing-market processes and state housing policy. *Housing in Britain* will appeal to those with an interest in the history of British housing policy and debates, and the history of social policy in Britain.
