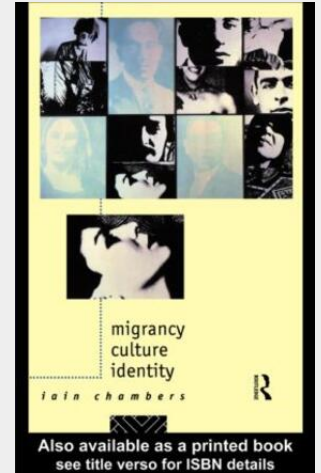


Chambers
