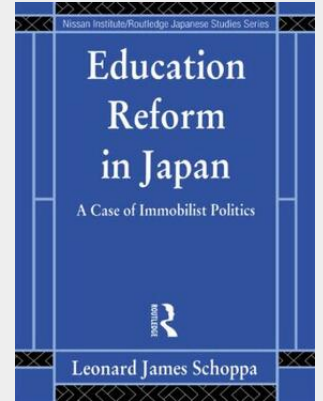

## Education Reform in Japan
