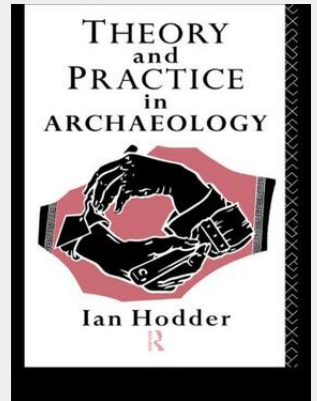


Hodder
