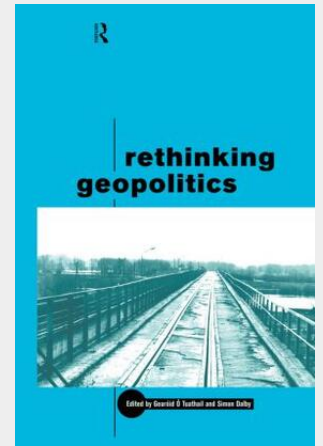


Rethinking Geopolitics
