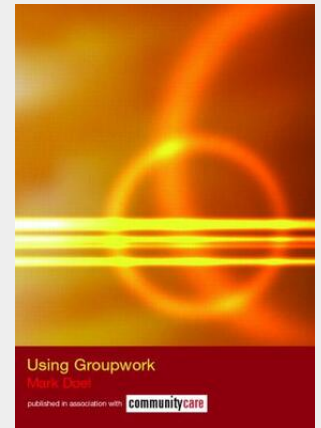


Using Groupwork
