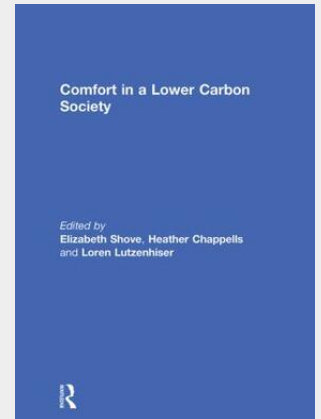


Comfort in a Lower Carbon Society
