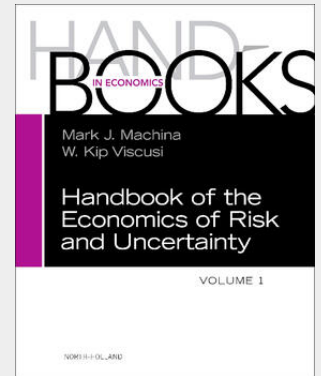


Handbook of the Economics of Risk and Uncertainty
