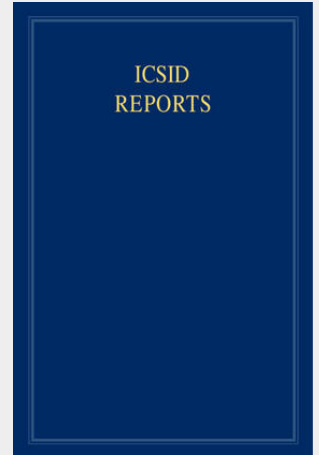


ICSID Reports
