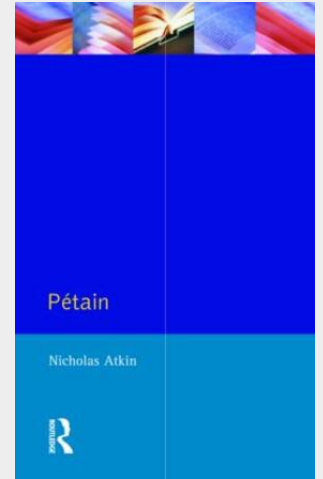


Atkin
