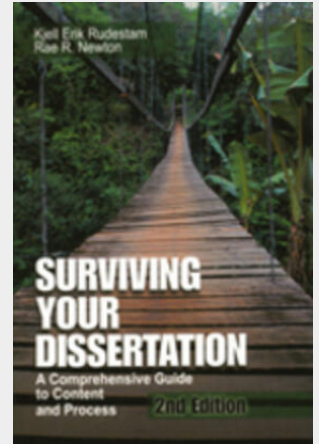


Surviving Your Dissertation
