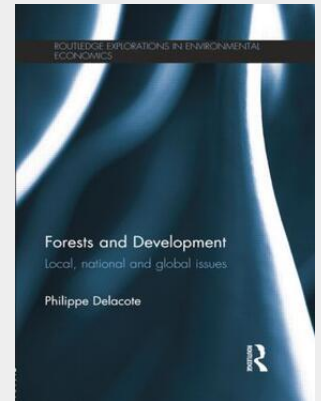


Economic Geography and the Unequal Development of Regions
