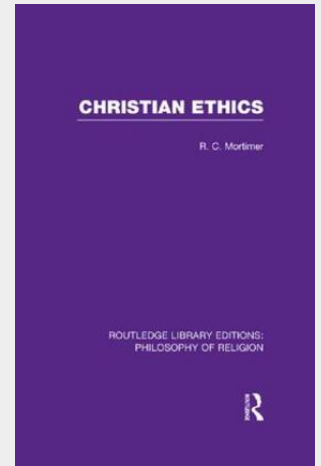


Mortimer
