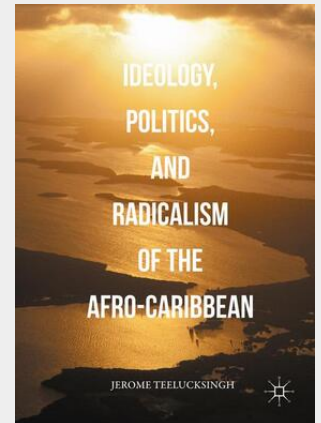


Ideology, Politics, and Radicalism of the Afro-Caribbean
