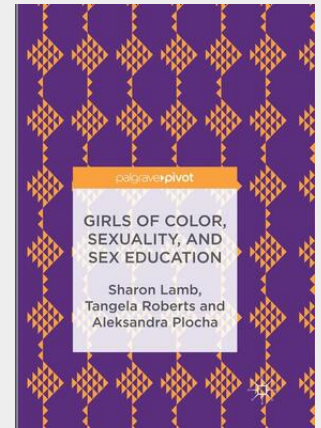


Girls of Color, Sexuality, and Sex Education
