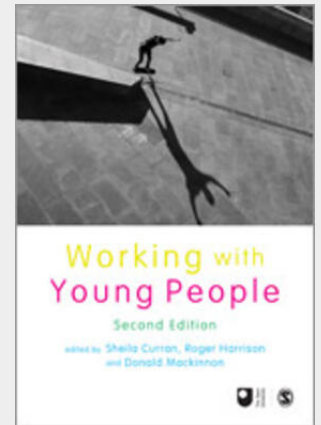


Working with Young People
