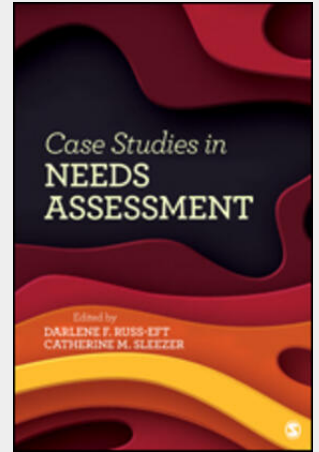


Case Studies in Needs Assessment
