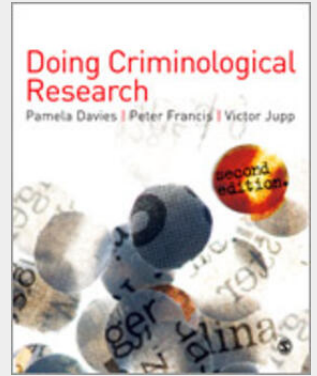


Doing Criminological Research
