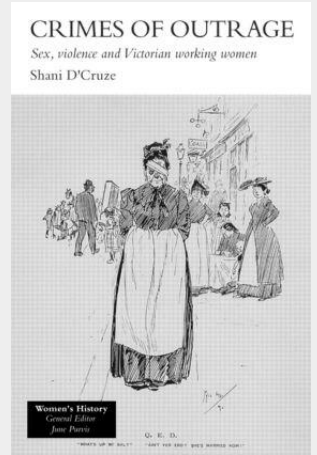

This provocative study explores the subordination of Victorian working women in the home, neighborhood, and workplace.
