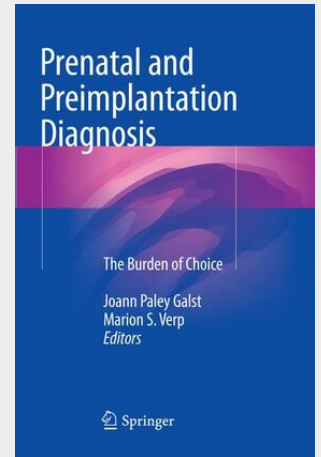


Prenatal and Preimplantation Diagnosis
