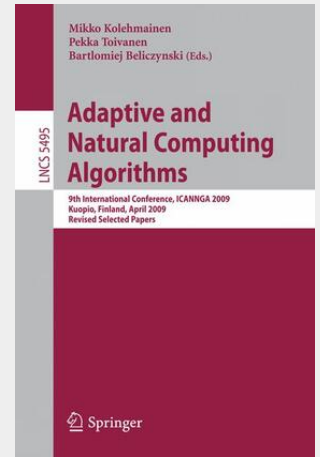


Adaptive and Natural Computing Algorithms

9th International Conference, ICANNGA 2009, Kuopio, Finland, April 23-25, 2009,

The ICANNGA series of conferences has been organized since 1993 and has a long history of promoting the principles and understanding of computational intelligence paradigms within the scientific community. Originally ICANNGA stood for "International Conference on Artificial Neural Networks and Genetic Algorithms," but in 2005 the conference was renamed to "International Conference on Adaptive and Natural Computing Algorithms," while keeping the acronym ICANNGA. The first ICANNGA conference was held in Innsbruck Austria (1993), then Alès in France (1995), Norwich in the UK (1997), Portoroz in Slovenia (1999), Prague in the Czech Republic (2001), Roanne in France (2003), Coimbra Portugal (2005) and Warsaw in Poland (2007). Continuing this European tradition, the 9th ICANNGA was held in Kuopio, Finland (2009). The vast majority of ICANNGA conferences is organized by and based at a university. Drawing on the experience of previous events and following the same general model, ICANNGA 2009 combined plenary lectures and technical sessions. Apart from being a widely recognized conference, it enhanced the possibility to exchange opinions through lectures and discussions, provided a great opportunity to meet new colleagues, as well as to renew old friendships and to facilitate the possibilities for international collaborations. As previously, the conference proceedings are published in the Springer LNCS series.
