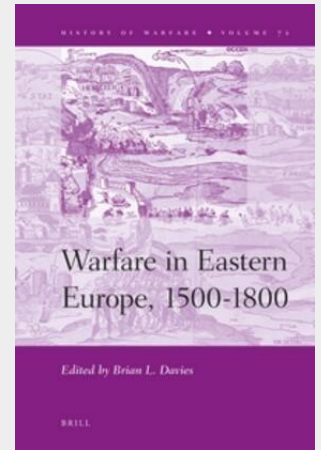


Warfare in Eastern Europe, 1500-1800
