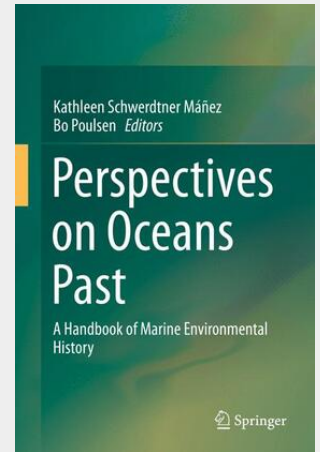


Perspectives on Oceans Past
