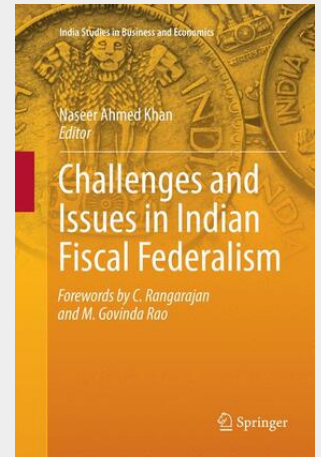


## Challenges and Issues in Indian Fiscal Federalism
