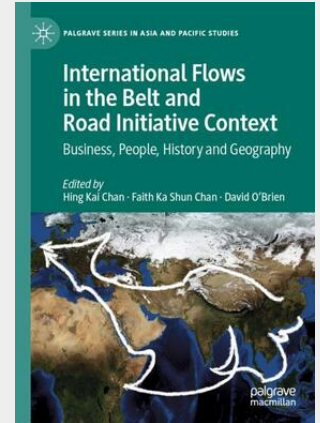


International Flows in the Belt and Road Initiative Context
