

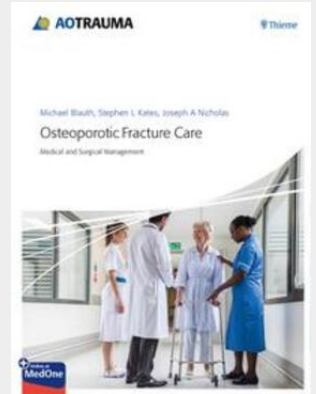
Osteoporotic Fracture Care
